

Cedarmere School's Reopening Information

8:30-3:00 pm

We are looking forward to transitioning to hybrid instruction! This is new for all of us. We will continue to communicate important information and updates. Here are some important reminders to help you and your child prepare for returning to the building:

School begins for students at 8:30 am each day and dismissal is at 3:00 pm. The doors for students will open at 8:15 am, and early dismissal ends at 2:30 pm.

Arrival

In order for us to maintain social distancing. Students will enter in the morning as follows:

Prekindergarten: Classroom Doors
Kindergarten: Side Right Entrance (Beside Gym)
1st & 2nd Grade: Will enter their classrooms through their classroom doors.
3rd Grade - Side Right Entrance
4th Grade - Main Entrance (Center)
5th Grade - Side Left Entrance
CLS Students - Side Right Entrance
Learning Cottage Students - Will go directly to the Learning Cottages

Late Arrivals

If students arrive late, parents will need to call the office, so someone can come meet your child upon arrival. As parents will not be allowed to enter the building.

Dismissal Procedures

Dismissal for Cedarmere will remain the same as it was last school year, however due to our need to maintain social distancing, there will be an extended amount of time for dismissal.

Bus Riders

Will continue to exit out of the main door, escorted by an adult. Students who ride the bus must sit on the bus one student to a seat, unless they have a sibling. Siblings can sit together.

Car Riders & Walkers, will continue to exit by the door on the right. Parents will need to stagger and maintain social distancing while waiting for their children. Parents must park their vehicles and walk up to the door and please wait patiently while we call your child's number to meet you. The first few weeks of school this may take a much longer time, so we ask you to please be patient. (Each child will be assigned a

Face Covering:

- Face coverings are required for all persons in a BCPS facility or vehicle as well as on BCPS property. Face coverings are required during transportation to/from school on a bus as well as outdoors on campuses.
- Each school, office, and school bus will have a supply of disposable face coverings for students and employees who forget their face covering or whose face covering becomes soiled or damaged.

number to display to the adult and they will have your child come to you, once you present your assigned school number for your child).

Early Dismissal

The office will need a 24-hour notice if you want your child dismissed early. Parents will need to call the office and a staff member will bring your child to meet you in your vehicle. Please make sure you have your identification with you to be displayed. Early dismissal ends at 2:30 pm.

Screening & Stay Home When Appropriate:

- All employees and students are expected to screen themselves daily for symptoms of COVID-19.
- **Remain home** if you have symptoms, confirmed COVID-19 illness, had recent contact with a person with COVID-19 and/or awaiting test results.
- Parents will receive a screening checklist and magnet with the screening practices.

Social Distancing:

- Classroom furniture is arranged to provide 6-foot separation between students, when possible.
- Reduce gathering of students in any area – refer to changes in arrival and dismissal procedures and movement in the hallways.

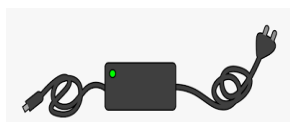
Hand Hygiene:
